THE SITUATION

In rural communities across India, farming is the main source of food and income for many people. But because of drought and changing climate patterns, there is a lack of water for irrigation. The land is rocky and sandy, which causes soil erosion and shrinks the amount of land available for cultivating crops. This has a detrimental effect on people's livelihoods and access to food. Approximately 55 percent of the population of Chhindwara in Madhya Pradesh must migrate to other places for work, and Madhya Pradesh has one of the highest rates of malnourished children in India.

That's why ELCA World Hunger is partnering with our companions in India to support new food and agriculture projects that fight food insecurity.
