Margaret Mitchell House (www.atlantahistorycenter.com)

Follow the footsteps of Southern author, Margaret Mitchell, where she wrote the Pulitzer-Prize winning book, *Gone With the Wind*. The Margaret Mitchell House is located at Atlanta History Center's Midtown campus approximately 5 miles South down Peachtree Street.

The building is a turn-of-the-century, three-story, Tudor Revival building and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The Margaret Mitchell House provides an apt setting for learning about Mitchell's motives for writing the novel and the lifestyle she lived with her husband, John Marsh, in 1920s Atlanta.

The Swan House (www.atantahistorycenter.com)

Catch a glimpse of lifestyles of the rich and famous circa 1930s era Atlanta. Pause for enamoring mansion views from the Swan House Lawn then meet the Inman family and travel back in time surrounded by beauty, high taste and luxurious Southern charm.

Swan House, traditionally known as one of the most recognized and photographed landmarks in Atlanta, is an elegant, classically styled mansion built in 1928 for the Edward H. Inman family, heirs to a cotton brokerage fortune. The mansion, designed by famed Atlanta architect Philip Trammell Shutze, provides a glimpse into the lifestyle of this Atlanta family during the 1920s and 1930s. Explore the many rooms of this beautifully restored historic house and enjoy gardens, fountains and breathtaking views on the Swan House grounds. We offer a variety of experiences at the Swan House including Open House Experiences and a special Capitol Tour.

Entrance into the Swan House is included in the ticket price of the Atlanta History Center.



The High Museum of Art (www.high.org)

The High Museum of Art, located in Atlanta, is the leading art museum in the Southeastern United States. Located on Peachtree Street in Midtown, the city's arts district, the High is a division of the Woodruff Arts Center.

Centennial Olympic Park
