CC ACTION

Recommended:

To receive the request to explore creation of the position of a Racial Justice Ombudsperson; To acknowledge the previous action of the council to create "a task force charged with reviewing the current process for discipline and its impact on persons of color and other historically marginalized groups, considering recommendations for staffing, community healing and restoration, and learning best practices from full communion partners" (CC22.04.04); and To review the role and membership of the ELCA Response Team.
