According to provision 13.52., "The treasurer shall be elected by the Church Council to a six-year term and serve until a successor takes office." Churchwide bylaw 19.01.01., specifies "The treasurer shall be elected by a two-thirds vote of the Church Council." The term of the treasurer, elected at the November 2023 meeting of the Church Council, will begin on February 1, 2024.

In accordance with provision 13.51., "The treasurer shall serve under the presiding bishop of this church." Bishop Eaton is recommending re-election of Ms. Lori Fedyk to the Executive Committee, who will forward it to the Church Council for consideration. Additional information related to the recommendation will be provided in executive session.
