IWL Student Helps Ukrainian Refugees Overcome Barriers in Poland

Since the Russia-Ukraine War began in February 2022, over 1.4 million refugees have arrived in Poland and registered to stay there — more than in any other country. Several Lutheran churches are providing support for them, including the Evangelical Church of the Augsburg Confession in Poland. This is the church Kornelia Rudkowska, an International Women Leaders scholarship recipient, calls home. Last year her mother, Katarzyna, became one of the first nine Lutheran women to be ordained in Poland. Katarzyna is local director of the "I Overcome Barriers" program, which helps Ukrainian refugees master the Polish language.

"Refugees, despite the fact that they often have high professional qualifications,

do not find work," Kornelia says. "The biggest barrier is the poor knowledge of the Polish language." The project is supported by the Lutheran World Federation and contributions from member churches and institutions, including Newberry College, where Kornelia is a sophomore.
