Through academic scholarships, engagement in gender justice, and short-term leadership experiences, the International Leaders Program is forming leaders for both church and society.

INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Through the International Scholarship Program, the ELCA awards academic scholarships to established and emerging leaders selected and endorsed by global companion churches and institutions. With generous financial support, these scholars study a wide variety of subjects at schools around the world, including our excellent ELCA seminaries. Further equipped for mission and ministry, they return to their sending churches and communities as pastors, professors, bishops, medical doctors, social workers, engineers and teachers, and in many other key leadership roles.

INTERNATIONAL WOMEN LEADERS

Alongside the global Lutheran community, the ELCA is engaging in a strategic emphasis on equipping women leaders in the life and development of church and society. Through International Women Leaders, we are providing additional scholarships to women sent by global companions. These emerging leaders study at ELCA colleges and universities, ELCA seminaries, and other institutions around the world. They enrich the ELCA through their witness and leadership and multiply the impact of their studies back home.

GLOBAL LEADERSHIP ACADEMY

Through the Global Leadership Academy, the ELCA is creating shortterm education and training opportunities for leaders of our global companions. We partner with companions to host these gatherings in varied contexts around the world, rooting our learning in the stories and expertise of local change-makers. The academy brings these leaders together to learn, connect and build a global network of justice advocates. Participants return home equipped to lead change in their communities.



OVERALL IMPACT




