A. Proposed Social Message on Government and Civic Engagement

The Proposed Social Message on Government and Civic Engagement was written at the request of the 2019 Churchwide Assembly [CA19.05.29] and authorized by the Church Council [19.11.47w].

<u>Social messages</u> are teaching documents of the ELCA focused on particular social topics. They are intended to focus attention and urge action on timely, pressing matters of social concern to church and society. ELCA social statements are more comprehensive documents developed via a five-year process led by a task force and adopted at churchwide assemblies. At its June 19 meeting, Program and Services Committee reviewed and approved the amendments to the <u>Proposed Social Message on Government and Civic Engagement</u> and now recommends its adoption.
