As a Lutheran and your constituent, I am deeply concerned about policies Congress is considering to provide protection for young Americans without legal status, also known as Dreamers, that would harm vulnerable children and families. Legislation to protect Dreamers, such as the Dream Act (S. 1615/H.R. 3440), should pass without additional provisions. Dreamers are pastors, congregants and vital leaders in ministries throughout the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA). I urge you to voice your support for the passage of the Dream Act without additional provisions that would harm children and families.
