The theme for the 2018 ELCA Youth Gathering is "This Changes Everything," and the primary Scripture will be Ephesians 2:8: "For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God." The new logo is a visual representation of the theme and the experience of the Gathering, and the cross at the center is the focus – it is God's grace, through Christ's life, death and resurrection, that changes everything for all people.

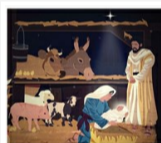
