It's time to nominate students for Lutheran Summer Music


Every year, the primary way that music students find their way to LSM is through the encouragement of their church musician! LSM offers opportunities for musicians of all kinds: brass, winds, strings, percussion, piano, organ, voice, harp, guitar, handbells, and more! Students receive advanced musical instruction through large ensembles (festival choir, band and orchestra), chamber music, private lessons with collegiate-level faculty and elective classes (such as conducting, composition, church music, introduction to the pipe organ, jazz band, musical theatre, music therapy). In the evenings students attend recitals, evening prayer services and social events with their friends.

LSM 2024 takes place at Valparaiso University in Valparaiso, Ind., from June 30 to July 28 (full session) or June 30 to July 14 (half session) and is open to students who have completed grades 8-12. **Know a musical young person who would thrive at LSM?** Nominate them today.

Gathered Into One: Devotions for Lent 2024

Gathered into One provides daily devotions for each day from Ash Wednesday to the Resurrection of Our Lord/Vigil of Easter (traditionally known as Holy Saturday). Devotions begin with an evocative image and a brief passage from 1 Corinthians. The writers then bring their diverse voices and pastoral wisdom to the texts with quotations to ponder, reflections and prayers. The apostle Paul writes 1 Corinthians after hearing of quarreling and divisions among the people, emphasizing a theme of unity amid diversity that is as timely now as it was when Paul was writing.
